ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.58 dated 05.04.2017 registered under Sections 376, 506 of IPC and lateron added offences under Sections 376-D, 363, 323 of IPC at Police Station City Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the complaint is by a married women but she has not given the true facts and though she was married in 1998 the divorce petition had been dismissed. The counsel urges that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and 5 days later she names the petitioner in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. and does not disclose how she came to know of his identity and the prosecutrix has also been examined on 07.02.2018. He also contends that the trial is taking time and the MLR shows that there was no injury.

The statements of the prosecutrix and main witnesses have been recorded.

Petitioner is in custody for over 8 months.

The trial is taking time. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.
