This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Complaint Case No.372-1 of 29.05.2013, CIS No.COM1/1177/2013 pending in the court of JMIC, Fazilka titled as Wazir Singh Vs. Ram Avtar and others filed under sections 191, 192, 420, 465, 467, 468, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Sadar Fazilka.

On 16.12.2017 while issuing notice of motion the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Notice of motion returnable for 19.02.2018.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within 10 days. On doing so, he shall be released on interim bail by the learned trial Court to its satisfaction.

The petitioner to surrender his passport with the trial Court, if he possesses the same.”

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has furnished in Court today copy of proceedings dated 21.12.2017 before the JMIC, Fazilka and a perusal thereof indicates that the petitioner has put in appearance before the Trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Furthermore, the order dated 21.12.2017 passed by the JMIC, Fazilka also took note of the statement made by complainant Wazir Singh that he has compromised the matter with the accused/present petitioner with the intervention of the respectable persons and does not wish to proceed with the complaint.

In the light of the circumstances noticed herein above, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted. The order dated 16.12.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
