The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 8 dated 08.01.2018 under Sections 325, 323, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 16.04.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded with regard to genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dera Basi has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the Complainant-Sourav and also of the accused, namely, Monika, Sham Lal

and Radha have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant-Sourav has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dera Bassi, that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence, threat or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 8 dated 08.01.2018 under Sections 325, 323, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
