In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.338, dated 16.09.2016, under Sections 406/420/506/120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention since 26.09.2017.
3. The prayer of bail is opposed on behalf of the State.
4. Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of the State submits that though investigation in the present case is already complete, yet the petitioner should not be released in view of his antecedents to the effect that

he is involved in three more cases of identical nature, in which he allegedly duped the victims with similar false promises of providing large monetary gains.

5. Be that as it may, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner in the present case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Mukesh Kumar son of Ram Kumar, is directed to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds of ₹2.5 Lacs with two sureties of ₹1.25 Lacs each, of which one of whom shall have to be a sitting office bearer of the Panchayat or equivalent Local Body and any other condition as may be deem fit and to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, concerned.
