This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner vide FIR No.09 dated 24.09.2017 under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station STF, Phase IV, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel contends that the recovery of heroin effected from the petitioner, is non-commercial in nature. He is stated to be in custody since 24.09.2017.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the recovery effected from the petitioner is non-commercial in nature, period of his incarceration and the fact that the trial may take long time to conclude, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner during pendency of the trial. I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, petition is

allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, SAS Nagar (Mohali).
