Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.149 dated 09.10.2013 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Bhikhwind, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it is on account of absence of the petitioner on 29.08.2018, his bail was cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued against him for 10.09.2018. The petitioner is otherwise ready to appear before the trial Court. He further states that there is no other case against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that there being a single default on the part of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner appears before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and move an application for grant of regular bail, he shall be admitted on bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

The petitioner shall also submit an affidavit before the trial Court that in future, he shall not make himself absented in the trial.
