ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.61 dated 11.07.2018 registered under Sections 376, 323, 506 IPC and Section 3 of SC/ST Act (added later on) at Police Station City-1 Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the complainant and the petitioner are married and it was consensual and the complainant is married with children and the investigation is over and challan has been presented. Counsel states that the MLR is available on record which shows that there is no injury and the complaint is only of pain.

Investigation is over. Challan has been presented. Trial would take time but without commenting anything on the merits of the case,

petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court with a condition that the petitioner would not contact the prosecutrix or tamper with the evidence in any manner.
