Petitioner seeks regular bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in case FIR No.355 dated 4.6.2018 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Sadar Bhiwani.

Allegations are that Pardeep son of Satbir defrauded five persons to the tune of ₹ 20,00,000/- on the pretext of getting them employment in the Army. Pardeep is stated to have issued a cheque which bounced. Allegations against the petitioner are that he used to procure medical certificate. Petitioner was arrested in this case on 4.6.2018 and he is in custody since then.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application by contending that four other cases are registered against the petitioner. However, in those cases, petitioner is on bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that Amit who is similarly situated has been granted bail by the lower court. All the offences are triable by the Magistrate. Petitioner is in custody for last five months. Since conclusion of the trial would take time, there is no ground for further detention of the petitioner for indefinite period. Consequently, the

present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to any other condition so imposed by the trial Court.
