At this stage, no finding of fact can be given on the assertions of learned counsel for the petitioner, yet respondent No.2 can be asked to have a fair look on the grievance of the petitioner which appears to have been started with selling of land to respondent No.4 who in turn did not pay the consideration, rather the cheque issued by him stood dishonoured for which complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act has been filed by the petitioner.
