Petitioner Jitender @ Jony has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.558 dated 28.09.2016, registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 302, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He has given kick blows to deceased Neeraj and is also stated to have given one injury on the right side of head to complainant

Sanjay with iron rod and that injury has been declared to be simple.

The petitioner has been in custody since 29.09.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the custody period; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
