Petitioner was engaged as a White Washer on Daily Wage basis by the office of XEN, PWD (B&R), Construction Division No.1, Kapurthala w.e.f. 01.12.1981 till termination of his engagement i.e. 15.7.1984. Petitioner raised a demand notice on 13.08.1988 leading to the reference and an Award dated 10.12.1993 passed by the Labour Court, Jalandhar whereby the prosecution was set aside and reinstatement with continuity of service and full back wages from the date of demand notice was granted in favour of the petitioner-Workmen. Petitioner was reinstated and his services were regularized. However, since the continuity of services was restricted w.e.f from the date of demand notice, the present writ petition has been filed.

the present writ petition has become infructuous as the services of the petitioner have been reckoned from the date of his initial date of engagement i.e. 01.12.1981 vide a speaking order dated 13.12.2017.

In view of the above, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
