Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.55 dated 21.05.2017 registered under Sections 307, 341, 427, 506, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition so far as petitioner No.1-Joga Singh is concerned.

In view of above, present petition qua petitioner No.1-Joga Singh stands dismissed as withdrawn.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prem Singh, states that pursuant to order dated 13.11.2018, petitioner No.2-Surinder Singh has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more

required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.11.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner No.2 shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
