Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 6 to take appropriate action as per the order dated 29.09.2017 (Annexure P4) passed by the trial Court.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punahna on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6 filed in the Court is taken on record.

As per the reply, the FIR No.53 dated 02.02.2016 under Sections 166, 167, 193, 195, 196, 218, 219, 220, 330, 342, 365, 489-B, 120-B IPC, Section 17 of the NDPS Act and 3 of the SC & ST Act was registered at Police Station Punahna against the private respondents and respondent No.8/accused namely Mehboob was formerly arrested on 21.12.2017 when he surrendered before the Illaqa Magistrate. The other

accused namely Nanak has joined the investigation on 13.01.2018 as per the order of Additional Sessions Judge, Nuh and challan has been presented against them. It is further stated that accused – Mustak son of Israil and Mehboob Khan have filed CRM-M No.3971 of 2018 in which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to them vide order dated 05.04.2018.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Bachu Singh, further submits that the police is trying to arrest the remaining accused persons.

In view of above, this petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
