Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ravinder Singh, Police Station NRI Cell, Mohali submits that in consequence of interim order dated 06.11.2018, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him. He does not oppose the grounds of bail and the parties have compromised the matter, which fact is acceded to at the bar by the learned counsel Mr. Sanjay Tangri, appearing for the complainant.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.11.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2)
