Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass the petitioners on the basis of FIR No.92 dated 18.10.2018 under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station City-1, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the son of the petitioners, namely, Mohd. Rizwan is living separately and he is not under their control. He had been disowned by the petitioners from their property on 04.06.2010, but still the police is harassing the petitioners by calling them to Police Station.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh states that the petitioners are not required in the aforesaid FIR and it is only to

trace out the whereabouts of their son Mohd. Rizwan, the police visited the house of the petitioners.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, but taking into consideration the stand of learned State Counsel, which is based on the instructions of ASI Avtar Singh, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioners are required in the case/FIR registered against their son Mohd. Rizwan, they would be served a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.
