This is an application under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0093 dated 29.5.2018 under Section 325/323/506 IPC (later on added Section 307 IPC), registered at Police Station Division No. 3, Ludhiana.

Petitioner who is mentioned as Vicky Singh Khalsa in the FIR being the owner of Khalsa Sweets attacked one Anil Kumar Jain on account of parking of rehri and caused injuries on his head. As per the CT scan report, injury on the head is fracture on the left side of the occipital bone and is declared dangerous to life.

In that view of the matter, no ground to grant anticipatory bail  
to the petitioner is made out.
