Learned State counsel submits that petitioner No. 2- Jaswant Singh had made a statement before the investigating officer, namely Karan Singh, Incharge of Police Post Chauki Gatoli that followers of his son had come to their rescue to protect their life and liberty.

Therefore, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous in view of the fact that petitioners can make their own arrangements for their security as they are well equipped with their followers to protect their life and liberty. That apart petitioner No. 1 has already been granted arm license whereas application for grant of arm licence of petitioner No. 2 is under process.

According to learned State counsel, on instructions from

ASI Kulbir Singh, Investigating officer, Superintendent of Police, Jind

has already granted permission to issue arm license to petitioner No.

2. However, the same is pending with District Magistrate, Jind.

The District Magistrate, Jind is directed to do the needful within one month.
