Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Varinder Kumar, Police Station Women, Patiala submits that in consequence of interim order dated 06.11.2018, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and he does not oppose the grounds of bail, which is sought to be opposed by the learned counsel for the complainant on the ground that certain gold ornaments are yet to be recovered.

Heard.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.11.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
