The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.37 dated 17.3.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 22 of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act (for short, "NDPS") at Police Station Goraya, Jalandhar Rural.
