This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.47 dated 27.8.2017 under Section 379, 411 & 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner and he has verified that no other criminal case is pending against him.
