Mr. Rajesh Bansal, Advocate, has put in appearance and filed power of attorney on behalf of complainant in Court today on his own and same is taken on record.

Heard.

Allegations are that complainant, namely, Ravinder Kumar, working as Inspector in Food and Supply Department, on 7.9.2018, at about 12:00 pm, he came to Baberpur office of Food and Supply. Accused Rajbir Singh arrived there and made certain remarks about his caste. Complainant was also abused.

The learned counsel for petitioner has argued that earlier, a complaint was made against complainant in this case on account of which he was placed under suspension and that present FIR is nothing, but a counter blast to said complaint.

After considering facts and circumstances, I am of the view that

in present case, it is yet to be examined as to whether remarks, as alleged, were made in a manner, as alleged. At this stage, there is no need to keep petitioner behind bar. As such, petition is allowed. It is directed that in the event of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
