Heard. Earlier this Court, vide order dated 1.11.2018, passed in CRM-M-48789-2018, had disposed of anticipatory bail application of the petitioner with a direction to surrender before trial Court within one week and file application for regular bail. It was further directed that application for regular bail, if so filed, shall be decided on the same day after issuing notice to counsel for complainant. Petitioner was also directed to deposit Rs. 3,000/- in terms of orders of learned Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that now the counsel appearing for petitioner before trial Court has informed him that petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in said case under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, on 15.10.2018. He further stated that there were Diwali holidays and he filed this application before this Court on 8.11.2018.

It being so, notwithstanding that petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender, petitioner is directed to comply with order passed by this Court on 1.11.2018 in CRM-M-48789-2018, for which fresh period of seven days is granted to him. Saturday and Sunday (10.11.2018 and 11.11.2018) being holidays, fresh period will start from Monday (12.11.2018).
