Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents i.e. respondents No.5 & 6.

Vide order dated 09.11.2018, while issuing notice of motion, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar was directed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6. These respondents were also directed to be served by way of dasti process.

As per office report, dasti notices issued for respondents No.5 and 6 have not been collected by the counsel for the petitioners. Even otherwise, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh,

not apprehending any threat to their life and liberty. Though this fact was required to be brought to the notice of this Court by the petitioners themselves, but they have conveniently withheld this information.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.
