INDERJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.49 dated 18.02.2016, registered at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala, under Sections 186, 332, 353, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on 18.02.2016. As per the petitioner, he was granted regular bail on 19.01.2017 in this case and he appeared regularly before

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the Court. In the meantime, he was taken into custody in another case and remained absent from the court proceedings in the present case in the month of May, 2018. Now, he has been in custody since 06.08.2018 in this case.

The petitioner is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
