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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Heard. Petitioner seeks regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 165, dated 5.6.2014, registered under Sections 379, 411, 467, 468, 471 IPC, at Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh.

It is alleged that a black colour bullet motorcycle, having registration No. CH-04-F-4938, belonging to complainant Lakhbir Singh, was stolen and present petitioner got fake number plate affixed on it and got it transferred in the name of Karnail Singh. Though, according to Karnail Singh, present petitioner is real owner of said motorcycle.

Merits of case are not to be examined. On the asking of Court, the learned Standing Counsel appearing for UT Chandigarh, has stated that there is no other previous case registered or pending against petitioner.

Since disposal of case will take time, therefore, there is no justification for further detention of petitioner. Petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.
