ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.68 dated 24.10.2017, under Sections 120-B, 323, 34, 376, 406, 498-A and 506 IPC, registered at Women Police Station, Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an off-shoot of the matrimonial dispute between the parties.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 02.07.2018, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bimla, who is present in Court today, states that the parties have compromised the matter and they are happily residing together in their matrimonial home. It is further stated that petitioner has joined the investigation but recovery is yet to be made.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 02.07.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
