The grievance of the petitioner is that the private respondents obtained a false and fictitious decree against one Gurdayal Singh (father-in-law of the petitioner) after his death and thus, deprived the petitioner of her rights. A representation dated 19.9.2018 (Annexure P1) has been submitted, but the police has not taken any action till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 8, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P1) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
