The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.438 dated 21st June, 2017, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34, 379-B and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the IPC') (Sections 216, 201, 302 of the IPC added later on) at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

2. Mr. Manvinder Chauhan, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of complainant and filed his Power of Attorney today in Court; Be kept on record.

3. The co-accused namely Ronak was granted bail by this Court in CRM-M No.45568 of 2017 on 11th January, 2018 in view of the limited role attributed to him in the occurrence.

4. The petitioner stands on an absolutely identical footing as the allegations against him in the FIR is the same as against the co-accused-Ronak.

5. As such considering, petitioner's prolonged detention at this stage, he may released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
