Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.137 dated 02.05.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC, registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 01.03.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Raj Kumar, has submitted that two of the co-accused, namely, Rakesh Kumar and R.K.Verma have been arrested and recovery of ₹3 lacs has been effected and they were on regular bail. It is further submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

However, learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the recovery of an amount of ₹.3 lacs is to be effected from the petitioner and, therefore, he is not entitled for grant anticipatory bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the submissions as noticed in the order dated 01.03.2018, the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute.
