In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.193, dated 10.09.2017, under Sections 379-B, 323, 427, 148, 149 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code (later on added Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code), registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, Khanna, District Ludhiana.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 29.09.2017.
