The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.233 dated 14.09.2018, under Sections 354, 354-A IPC and under Section 12 of POCSO Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Patiala.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since September, 2018. The material witnesses have been examined. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application while saying that if the petitioner is released on bail, he may influence the witnesses.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition

is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
