Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.31, dated 19.06.2018, for the offences punishable under Sections 307,353,186,332,148,149 IPC and Sections 379,333 IPC(added later on) and Section 4(1) read with Section 21(1) of Mines and Mineral Regulations of Development Act registered at Police Station Mullanpur Garibdass, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even as per the case of prosecution, the petitioner was only sitting in the car along with the co-accused, against whom there are allegations that they were indulging in illegal mining. Learned counsel further contends that there is no attribution of any injury to any person as attributed to the petitioner. There is no other case of any kind against the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 19.06.2018. Challan has been filed and charge has already been framed in the case. Therefore, the petitioner is no more required for any further

investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Satwinder Singh submits that the injuries given to the injured are serious in nature. He has not even recovered so far. However, it is not disputed that the petitioner, as such, has not been attributed any injury to any person. It is also not disputed that there is no other case against the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted the concession of bail pending trial. He be released on bail pending trial subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
