In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.161, dated 08.05.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 120-B and 302 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonapat, District Sonapat.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 20.05.2017.

3. The petitioner was not named in the F.I.R. The other material relied upon against him is not tangible. His involvement in the occurrence as stated by maternal uncle of the deceased (who has since been already

examined as a prosecution witness) is on the basis of information from unspecified sources.

4. Considering these circumstances and without making any comment on the likely outcome of the pending trial, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Naveen @ Pinku son of Dharambir, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, concerned.
