Present petition is filed praying for quashing FIR No. 50 dated 05.03.2008, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar, on the basis of compromise dated 06.12.2017 entered into between the parties.

2. Heard.

3. Both the parties were directed by this Court vide order dated 20.12.2017 to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court and get their statements recorded and in pursuance thereof, learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar recorded the statements of both the

parties and submitted a report dated 28.03.2018. A perusal of the report reveals that the compromise entered into between the parties is voluntary and without any fear, coercion, inducement or threat. Even as on today the parties are not disputing the factum of compromise arrived at between them.

4. No objection has been raised by the learned State counsel on a specific query put to him by the Court with regard to quashing of the FIR as well as all other consequential proceedings on the basis of the compromise effected between the parties in this case.

5. In view of the above, this Court is fully convinced that the offences are entirely personal in nature and does not involve any public funds and thus quashing of FIR in question along with all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise would bring peace and harmony to secure the ends of justice. Consequently, the aforesaid FIR and all consequential proceedings resulting therefrom are quashed qua petitioner(s).

6. Petition is allowed.
