Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.191 dated 25.12.2016, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1 and contested this petition.

Respondent No.2-Lakhwinder Singh has also appeared through his counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that compromise in full and final settling the matter has already been effected between the parties and he has no objection if bail is granted to the petitioner.

The petitioner has been in custody since 11.09.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the fact that compromise has already been effected between the parties, I find that no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case. Therefore, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
