Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.141 dated 14.10,2017 registered under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar.

On 15.1.2018, following order was passed:-

“To be heard along with CRM-M No. 44920 of 2017 for 22.3.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer to join

investigation on 24.1.2018 and in the event of their arrest, they shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, submitted that the petitioners have already joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid, interim order dated 15.1.2018 is made absolute. However, petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Officer.

Petition stands disposed of.
