This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.132, dated 09.10.2017, under Sections 452/324/323/506/427/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code added later on), registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

2. Seen Case Diary along with fresh complaint of the complainant referred to in the earlier order dated 22.01.2018, which is produced before this Court.

3. Also seen the Video Recording of the occurrence as mentioned in the last para of the aforesaid fresh complaint/representation dated 01.01.2018.

4. Considering the available material inasmuch as the alleged attack imputed to the present petitioner cannot be verified from the available Recording, although it is the case of the State that such Recording got interrupted since the mobile device on which it was being captured fell away from the hand of the victim.

5. The present petition, in the given circumstances, is allowed and the petitioner, namely Harpinder Singh son of Nagar Singh, is directed to be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to compliance of the statutory conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
