The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Om Prakash, states that in this case, allegations are of firing in a marriage party. Two of material witnesses, namely, Rajesh and Jaswant, have been examined before trial Court. They have turned hostile and did not support prosecution case.

In view of fact that material witnesses have not supported prosecution case and considering that petitioner is in custody since 28.8.2018, further detention of petitioner is unjustified. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petition is allowed.
