GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents No.4 to 9 had illegally entered into his shop on 16.7.2018 and had beaten him and had damaged his property and were pressurizing him to pay an amount of ₹10 lakhs failing which he would be involved in some case under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although an application (Annexure P-1) in this regard was submitted to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda but no action had been taken thereupon.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-1) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest. It is further directed that in case, there is any genuine apprehension of threat to life and liberty of the petitioner, then adequate steps be taken so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-1) be sent to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
