This order shall dispose of all the four similar petitions against the similar orders, bearing CRM-M-48965-2017, CRM-M-11863-2017, CRM-M-11722-2017 and CRM-M-49092-2017.

Counsel for the petitioner restricts his arguments with regard to quashing of the order dated 08.08.2017, vide which non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner for appearance before the trial Court and seeks permission to withdraw the petitions with regard to other reliefs to approach the trial Court for redressal of his grievance.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is aged about 81 years. He is a chronic heart patient and is bed-ridden and even on 08.08.2017, he travelled from Kolkata to Ludhiana to attend the proceedings and was produced before the Court on a wheel chair. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner undertake to appear before the trial Court, if some reasonable time is granted and in this regard, petitioner's son has filed an undertaking by way of affidavit in the Court today.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the medical condition of the petitioner, all the four petitions are disposed of, granting liberty to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on 02.04.2018. The long date is given considering the request made on behalf of the petitioner that it is difficult for the petitioner to travel during winter times.

In view of the above, son of the petitioner namely Pawan Kumar Agarwala is directed to appear before the trial Court and furnish the personal undertaking that the petitioner-accused will appear before the trial Court on 02.04.2018.

Till 02.04.2018, the proceedings initiated by the trial Court for procuring the presence of the petitioner by way of adopting coercive method, shall remain stayed.

With the aforesaid observations, all the four petitions stand disposed of.
