A copy of order dated 17.11.2018, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Abohar, has been filed in Court today is taken on record.

Perusal of the above order shows that the petitioner surrendered before the trial Court and has been granted bail. Petitioner namely Ravi Kant Makkar has been summoned in a complaint dated 20.07.2015 (Annexure P-1) (registered as Complaint No.125 of 2015 dated 21.07.2015 titled as Veena Rani vs. Gulshan Makkar etc.) under Sections 302, 201, 34 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC.

It was alleged that the deceased was given Sulphase by the accused persons. But no injury mark was found on face or any other part of the body of the deceased.

Petitioner earlier surrendered before the trial Court, as such, interim

order dated 15.11.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
