The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.94 dated 02.09.2017, registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 IPC and 61 of the Excise Act, at Police Station City 2 Abohar, District Fazilka.

It has been submitted that the the petitioner is not named in the FIR.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Satpal, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 23.01.2018 is made

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absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)
Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
