This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.158 dated 24.8.2017 under sections 323, 341, 506, 451, 148, 149 I.P.C (sections 307 and 379 I.P.C were added later on), registered at Police Station, Kartarpur, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Salinder Singh would apprise the Court that in pursuance to the order dated 21.12.2017 the petitioner has since joined investigation.

That apart, it has gone uncontroverted that the injuries attributed to the present petitioner have been opined to be simple in nature.

In the considered view of this Court, custodial interrogation of the petitioner, as such, would not be warranted. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 21.12.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
