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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This is second attempt made by the petitioner by filing the instant petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking concession of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.66 dated 28.2.2017 registered under Sections 323, 325, 295-A, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana.

Earlier in point of time, petitioner had filed Criminal Misc.M-17802 of 2017 before this Court seeking concession of anticipatory bail and such petition had been dismissed vide detailed order dated 18.5.2017. Suffice it to observe, that the previous petition seeking identical relief had been dismissed by noticing that the attribution of an iron rod blow on the head of the complainant and with an intention to kill was to the petitioner

herein. Such version of the complainant also stood corroborated by the medical evidence. Injury No.1 attributed to the petitioner was on the forehead of the complainant. Such injury, concededly, has been reported to be grievous in nature by the Doctor after conduct of a CT Scan.

In spite of rejection of the petition seeking anticipatory bail by this Court on 18.5.2017, petitioner has chosen to evade the process of law and has not joined investigation.

This Court does not find any ground to accept the prayer made in the petition for anticipatory bail in the second petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Petition is dismissed.
