The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 1205 dated 25.09.2018 under Sections 148/149/323/452/427/506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

The operative part of the order dated 14.11.2018, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the accused persons/petitioners attacked the complainant by trespassing into the house of Hira and also caused damage to the household articles. Learned counsel further submits that now the matter has been compromised and the complainant has recorded a statement before the Illaqa Magistrate regarding the compromise. Notice of motion for 18.12.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 14.11.2018, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Santokh Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 14.11.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
