The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.63 dated 30.04.2015, registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga under Sections 376(2)(G) of Indian Penal Code and Sections 66/67 of Information and Technology Act, 2000.

Pursuant to the order dated 21.05.2018 the petitioner has joined the proceedings in the trial Court and is facing trial.

It is contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the investigating officer, submits that charges have been framed and the petitioner is facing trial in the trial Court and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for

custodial interrogation and has joined the proceedings before the trial Court, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 21.05.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
