Reply by way of affidavit of Ashish Chaudhary, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bilaspur (Yamuna Nagar) alongwith statements of petitioners and respondent Nos.3 and 4 has been filed. Same are taken on record.

The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their peaceful married life.

As per office report, in compliance of order dated 14.11.2018, petitioner No.2 Satpal has deposited Rs.50,000/- in the name of petitioner No.1 Pooja Rani.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the matter has been amicably settled and the petitioners apprehend no danger from the hands of private respondents and statements of the parties in this regard have already been recorded.

In view of above, the instant petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.

In case, the petitioners apprehend any threat to their life, limb and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.3 and 4, then they may approach the respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, who will provide the protection to them forthwith. If the situation so demands, the petitioners be also provided facility of Protection Home as per their requirement. However, this order shall not be applicable in case any act /conduct of any of the petitioners pertaining to the application, amounts to an offence.
