The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.146 dated 05.10.2017 registered under Section 307, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fategarh Sahib.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been roped under Section 120-B only and there is no direct attribution.

The above factual aspect of the matter has not been disputed by the learned State counsel. The investigation in the case is already complete and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been submitted. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

After hearing rival contentions of learned counsel for the parties and going through the paper-book, I am of the view that it would be just and appropriate if the concession of bail is granted to the petitioner. Moreover, the conclusion of trial is likely to take a long time, hence no

useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Jasvir Kaur be admitted to bail on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
