The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.82 dated 07.09.2013, registered at Police Station Women, District Patiala (Annexure P-1), under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC on the basis of compromise dated 17.04.2015 (Annexure P-2).

At this stage, Ms.Harmanpreet Kaur(Simmi), Advocate has put in appearance and filed Power of Attorney in Court today, which is taken on record. She admits the factum of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to the order dated 21.12.2017, report dated 21.02.2018 has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed and FIR No.82 dated 07.09.2013, registered at Police Station Women, District Patiala (Annexure P-1), under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC alongwith all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioner.
