The grievance of the petitioner is that he is being threatened by respondent Nos.4 to 6 because there is ongoing civil litigation between him and them. Despite representation dated 8.10.2018 (Annexure P4), no action has been taken by the police, till date.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day. In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 6, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P4) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. It shall be ensured that no harm comes to the life or property of the petitioner.
